# Arc of Onondaga

Arc of Onondaga began in 1951 when a group of concerned parents joined forces to ensure that their children would have educational opportunities. Today, Arc of Onondaga assists individuals with developmental disabilities achieve their fullest potential. As one of the largest providers of services to people with developmental disabilities in Onondaga County, Arc of Onondaga serves over 1,000 individuals and their families. With nearly 40 different sites throughout Central New York, Arc provides a wide array of support opportunities and services.

#### Residential

Our residential services strive to ensure that the people Arc supports are living in a home – not just a house – with the opportunity to mature, grow, and learn the skills necessary to be active, inclusive members of the community.

#### **Community Supports**

Day Habilitation supports people who possess a need for higher and intense training in order to make their community experience more positive. Arc's Day Hab Without Walls program promotes personal growth by bringing individuals out into the community daily through volunteer opportunities and civic connections. Community Habilitation helps people live in the least restrictive environment possible, allowing them the opportunity to access the community and build skills in the home while encouraging independence and establishing self-confidence.

#### **Employment Supports**

Arc of Onondaga provides choices and options for meaningful work experiences for people of all levels of ability. Whether it's working in the community at National Grid or Rite Aid, or among the many Enclaves locations, Arc of Onondaga ensures opportunities for significant training and work. The Employment Options program provides a range of services for adults seeking employment opportunities and students planning to transition from school to the world of work. Employment Options works in partnership with local businesses by providing them with successful personnel at no cost to their company and by providing on-site training, pre-screened applicants whose abilities match specific job requirements, and long-term support as necessary.

#### **Horizons Clinic**

Horizons Clinic, an Article 16 clinic, provides therapeutic, clinical services to individuals, enhancing their quality of life and helping them achieve their fullest potential. Horizons is a free-standing clinic certified by the New York State Office of People with Developmental Disabilities. Licensed, dedicated and professional staff provides all services offered by Horizons under the direction of a Board-certified physician. Horizons staff members are particularly familiar with the special needs of the people they serve.

#### Medicaid Waiver Respite / Community Recreation

Recreation programs provide activities in the community for both adults and teens with developmental disabilities. The programs are designed to educate individuals on the various recreational opportunities that exist in the community while at the same time helping them to meet new people, develop friendships, and have fun! Each program fosters the development of social skills, helps to promote independence, and provides opportunities for community inclusion.









# What Your Sponsorship Funds

The Arc of Onondaga Foundation was established to ensure the financial future of the Agency by securing community support. ## These are some of the most recently funded projects:

#### **Exercise equipment**

Treadmills and exercise bicycles were purchased and are being used by the people we support who have set goals to exercise more and improve their health.

#### Safety Fair

The Safety Committee presented its annual Safety Fair in September. Over 250 people attended. Grant funds were used to purchase giveaways for attendees. Everyone who came to this year's fair received an insulated lunch bag, water bottle, phone cleaner/ keychain, and cozies. The Safety Committee also purchased tee shirts to identify committee members and volunteers.

#### **Hydraulic Equipment**

Our clinical team identified the need for equipment to reduce the risk of harm to patients in our clinic spaces. Three hydraulic tables - for clinics at our Fremont, Galeville, and Salina Day Hab programs - were purchased and installed, and are being used daily.

#### **Multi-Terrain Wheelchairs**

Specially designed for unpaved surfaces such as sand and grass, two multi-terrain wheelchairs have been purchased to be used for outings to area parks and beaches. The wheelchairs have larger wheels which make destinations with difficult terrain much easier to access. The chairs are water-resistant, so people we support can sit and enjoy the water at area beaches without having to leave their chair.

#### **Dance Classes**

Again this year, people we support at our Lancaster Day Program took dance lessons. The lessons provided the opportunity for creative expression, physical activity, and increased confidence in movement.

#### **Wheelchair Scale**

A gentleman who lives in one of our residences used to require travel to another site to have his weight taken. A wheelchair scale was purchased for his home. He now enjoys privacy and no longer has to leave his home for weekly weight checks.

#### Sit to Stand Lift

A sit to stand lift was purchased to make transitions safer and easier for a resident who requires total transition from a bed or chair to a wheelchair. The lift is portable and can be used with other residents who may need it in the future, allowing them to age in the comfort of their home.

#### **Sensory Items**

Our Galeville Day Hab program received sensory items to help the people we support interact and engage their senses without risk. These sensory items help people explore without feeling frightened, frustrated, or overwhelmed.


